

PUBLIC NOTICE - Notice of a public hearing is hereby given pursuant to the provisions of the Agricultural Area Security Law, Act 43 of 1981, as amended, and the Sunshine Law, Act 84 of 1986, as amended. The West Vincent Township Board of Supervisors will hold the required public hearing on the mandated seven year review and re-adoption process for the Agricultural Security Area on Monday, November 20, 2017 at 7:00 PM at the West Vincent Township Building, 729 St. Matthews Road, Chester Springs, PA. The 1962.76 acre Agricultural Security Area (ASA), currently comprising of 80 parcels owned by 44 property owners, was originally adopted by the Board of Supervisors March 5, 1990. The purpose of said public hearing will be for the Board of Supervisors to consider the recommendations of the West Vincent Township Planning Commission and the Agricultural Security Area Advisory Committee, as well as the comments from the property owners and residents. The Township Planning Commission and the Agricultural Security Area Advisory Committee have recommended that the original ASA be readopted with revisions in the form of the addition of the following 2 parcels: Camphill Kimberton Village 25-4-107 and West Vincent Township 25-6-59.1. A list and map of the parcels of land recommended for re-adoption are available for inspection at the Township Building between 8:30 am and 4:30 pm weekdays.

Members of the public are invited to attend this public hearing.
