- ❖ A Ribbon Cutting event will be held on **Saturday, September 7, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. at 1422 St. Matthews Road, the Bryn Coed Park location**, to celebrate this achievement. To access the Park please enter the existing gravel driveway, and park on the left-hand side of the property in our public parking area. You will use the same access to enter the approximately 1-mile earthen loop trail. We encourage our community to attend and help us recognize the many stakeholders who made this Park a reality!

As you enjoy Bryn Coed Park, please follow these General Rules:

- ✓ The Bryn Coed Park is open Dawn to Dusk. Use of the Bryn Coed Nature Trail and Park are subject to the rules and regulations set forth in Ordinance No. 108-2001, <http://www.westvincentwp.org/township-park/>
- ✓ The Bryn Coed Nature Trail is an earthen trail intended for use by pedestrians and bicycles. No equestrian use of this trail is permitted. Please obey posted signs.
- ✓ A large portion of Bryn Coed Park is closed off to the public at this time. We encourage the public to enjoy the available trail, open space, and pond which are open at this time. Fishing in the pond is permissible, is catch and release only, and regulated in accordance with all fishing laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
- ✓ The Township is planning the demolition of existing farm buildings located on site. For your safety, the public is not permitted to enter any portion of the property located inside the orange fencing posted on site.
