Who's invited: Any *Equine* and *small livestock* operations that generate or land apply manure.

Why: Pennsylvania state law *requires* all operations that *generate or land apply manure to develop and implement* a written *Chapter 91 Manure Management Plan* to be compliant with state regulations in an effort to minimize the potential for nutrient pollution, to preserve and protect water quality, both locally and regionally.

What: The Chester County Conservation District Staff will be discussing PA regulations regarding manure management and will assist attendees in the development and completion of a written Manure Management Plan for their operations.

**** In addition to the workshop, Victoria Laubach of the Green Valleys Association will also be discussing the water quality of local watersheds, what it means, and how we can continue to protect and enhance these resources. Stream assessment results will also be reviewed.
