

Dear Representative Corbin:

This is in response to your correspondence dated August 8, 2017, on behalf of West Vincent Township, requesting the proposed and ultimate approval of the all-way stop at the intersection of Conestoga Road (S.R. 401) and South Chester Springs Road, and for the installation of the all-way stop be done **concurrently** with the removal of the gate at Eagle Farms Road and South Chester Springs Road.

The department has no objection to this request. Understandably, there will need to be coordination between PennDOT's Chester County sign crew and West Vincent Township's Public Works department. PennDOT will issue a work order for the installation of the appropriate signs for the all-way stop condition. Once all signs are in stock, Don Centofante of my staff will schedule an installation date and coordinate with the township. As our sign crew installs the all-way stop signs, West Vincent Township staff can remove the gate.

Mr. Centofante will reach out to the West Vincent Township Police Department to request its presence during this operation. The police presence will help insure the safety of the sign crew and the motoring public.

West Vincent Township will be sent a copy of the permit approving the all-way stop. If you need further information, please contact Ashwin Patel, P.E., District Traffic Engineer, at 610.206.6567.
