

MANAGER'S REPORT

October 3, 2016

Announcements:

- On September 13, 2016 the Phoenixville Community Health Foundation awarded the Police Department with a \$1,500 grant to be used towards the purchase of a new Automatic External Defibrillator, (AED). The AED will be placed in a patrol vehicle.
- On September 30, 2016, the Township received our 2016 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania state aid allocation for Volunteer Fire Relief for 2016, in the amount of \$49,717.75.
- On September 30, 2016, the Township received our 2016 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania state aid allocation for General Municipal Pension Plan System State Aid in the amount of \$96,242.21.
- The 2017 Budget Presentation is scheduled to take place at the next Board of Supervisors meeting on October 17, 2016.

French Creek Road Arch Replacement:

- Design and engineering underway. Awaiting status of DEP permit.

Buttonwood Lane Bridge:

- The Township Engineer and sub consultants are reviewing results of structural testing which will be used to determine extent of repair.

Fellowship Trail:

- The design of the Fellowship Trail Weatherstone Connection is underway.

Road Report:

- During the month of September, the road crew met with the Chester County Conservation District and the Township Engineer to review eligible areas in consideration of the PA Dirt & Gravel Road Program. According to the County, there are remaining 2016 grant funds that may be available to the Township for eligible projects. Staff is working on developing a scope of work and identifying project locations for their consideration.
- During the month of September, the road crew graded St. Andrews Lane and Jaine Lane. The road crew mowed roads, performed PA one calls, serviced equipment, filled potholes on St. Matthews Road, sprayed the sewer plants, and worked on traffic signs.
