PRESS RELEASE

On Wednesday, November 2, 2016, at approximately 1:19 am., Officers of the Uwchlan Township Police Department were dispatched to a home on Byers Road for the report of a home invasion armed robbery.

Upon arrival of the responding Officers, the residents reported that two black males, each armed with handguns, had entered the home and confronted them. Each of the family members were moved to one room of the home and each was physically restrained.

One family member, who momentarily hesitated in complying with the commands of one of the actors, was subsequently struck on the head by that actor, with a handgun that the actor had been displaying. That victim was treated on location by members of Uwchlan Ambulance Corp, before being transported to Paoli Memorial Hospital for additional care.

According to the victims, the actors made repeated demands for money. Once they were given all of the cash that the family had on hand, the actors fled the home. At this time there is no description of a vehicle that the actors may have been traveling in.

The Uwchlan Township Police Department was assisted by Officers from the Upper Uwchlan Township Police Department, the West Whiteland Township Police Department, the West Pikeland Township Police Department, the West Vincent Township Police Department, the East Whiteland Township Police Department, the Uwchlan Ambulance Corp, and the Chester County Sheriff's Department Canine Unit.
