The easiest way to reduce the size of your lawn, grow beautiful flowers, and help **MOTHER NATURE**

Layer 1 - Green - Your Lawn!
grass, leaves, weeds,
whatever's there!



**Layer 2 - Beige - Cardboard
with Rocks on Top**



**Layer 3 - Brown – Autumn
Leaves**



Directions

1. Figure out how big you want your garden to be. **ADVICE** – Start small! A nice size plot that will be easy to care for is 12' x 4'. We have a design for this size garden, although any size will help Mother Nature.
2. Use spray-paints or chalk or string to outline your garden.
3. Put down the layers. Feel free to add on top - compost, horse manure, coffee grounds, tea bags, veggie scraps, etc.
4. To make sure everything stays in place for the winter, surround your garden with a temporary fence or cover.
5. In the spring, the layers will have turned into rich compost, the grass and weeds underneath will be dead, and your soil will be healthy and ready to plant!
