

MANAGER'S REPORT

Announcements:

- The Citadel Country Spirit Music Festival was held August 24, 2018 through August 26, 2018 at the Ludwig's Corner Horseshow Grounds. The Police Department and Township staff, along with countless area law enforcement, emergency responders, and government officials assisted with the coordination of the event. Many thanks are extended to these individuals and agencies for their contributions to a largely successful event.
- The Phoenixville Regional Planning Committee conducted a public workshop to present the DRAFT Comprehensive Plan on Wednesday, August 29, 2018 from 7:00 p.m. - 9:00 p.m. at the Kimberton Fire Company. Feedback will be incorporated into the DRAFT plan. Additionally, Ed Theurkauf, project manager, will be attending the West Vincent Township Planning Commission meeting on September 20, 2018 at 7:30 p.m. to provide an overview of progress to date.
- The Township is sponsoring a free shredding event for West Vincent Township residents on Saturday, September 8, 2018 from 9:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. at the Township Parking Lot. Papers will be securely shredded by Proshred Security. No businesses please.

Department Reports:

- In the Building & Zoning Department (22) permit applications were processed.
- In the Finance Department the August Treasurer's Report has been completed and is posted on the website. The 2019 Budget process is underway.
- In the Road Department, the crew completed general maintenance to Township roads and vehicles as well as dealing with storm water drainage complaints due to frequent rain events. The repaving of Schoolhouse Lane will begin on September 10, 2018 and Flint Road is scheduled to be paved beginning September 17, 2018.
- The contractor for the replacement of the culvert on French Creek Road is awaiting the delivery of the precast culvert prior to commencing construction to begin on October 3, 2018. Utility companies will be on site relocating utilities during the week of September 17, 2018 in anticipation of the culvert replacement.
- According to PennDOT the Sheeder Mill Bridge is currently being repaired with an anticipated opening in late fall.
