Minutes from Apr 10 approved

WORK:

3. Liaison reports: BOS – Okd purchase Bryn Coed. Party planned? Nat Lands to be at Fire Hall Tues 24th at 6:30 to discuss plans for Bryn Coed. Sara – update on Ludwigs Corner development plan, Phase 1 – Wawa w gas station, pond & park, engineering plan – sidewalks, parking, stormwater management, trails, native planting, curbs, pervious paving, covered parking, solar panels, etc. 2007 decree changed agreement – Sara to send copy to Bernie, needs critical review by Sus Comm to forward to Planning Comm, Bernie suggested underground electric lines., discussed, Bernie will bring up at Planning Comm meeting along with Sus Comm “wish list”, cited several other places with buried lines.
